05/10/2022	Wednesday	Yom Kippur (Atonement Day)

On Fridays, on holiday eves and on intermediate days of Passover (17/04/2022 – 21/04/2022) and Tabernacles (11/10/2022 – 16/10/2022), the Bank's working hours are until 13:15 (Israel time).
